

## Ranges of Lighting Designers by Positions Per Season in Relation to Total Number of Lighting Designers and Lighting Design Positions

The following statistics are based on number of positions per designer over all seven seasons examined.

In lighting design, designers with an average of less than one position per season (less than 7 designs over the 7 seasons) were 68.3 percent of all lighting designers, and they held 20.8 percent of all lighting design positions. Lighting designers with an average of one to less than three positions per season (at least 7 but less than 21 designs over the 7 seasons) were 22.1 percent of all lighting designers, and they held 36.0 percent of all lighting design positions. Lighting designers with an average of three to less than five positions per season (at least 21 but less than 35 designs over the 7 seasons) were 6.8 percent of all lighting designers, and they held 25.8 percent of all lighting design positions. Lighting designers with an average of five to less than eight positions per season (at least 35 but less than 56 designs over the 7 seasons) were 2.3 percent of all lighting designers, and they held 14.1 percent of all lighting design positions. Lighting designers with an average of eight to less than nine positions per season (at least 56 but less than 63 designs over the 7 seasons) were 0.4 percent of all lighting designers, and they held 3.3 percent of all lighting design positions.
